



COLOSSEO This immense amphitheatre, of which we still admire the ancient splendour, was begun by Vespasian in A.D. 72 and finished by his son Titus in A.D. 80. Jewish prisoners were employed in its construction. Its real name is "Flavian Amphitheatre" and it could contain more than 50,000 spectators. Around the exterior run three orders of arches, respectively adorned with Doric, Ionic and Corinthian pilasters.

TRASTEVERE Trastevere is one of the most beautiful districts in Rome. It is formed by narrow streets and squares with a lot of craft shops, atelier, pubs and much more! Here you can try the real Roman cuisine in numerous restaurants. Enjoy your meal!



FORO ROMANO The Roman Forum is the most celebrated place in ancient Rome. It was the centre of the Roman life where its meetings, festivals and ceremonies took place. There are to be seen the remains of the ancient temples of all ages. It was damaged by a fire in 283 and restored by the Emperor Diocletian. From the fourth century AD it began to fall into decay - choosing the fate of Rome itself.

VATICANO It has been the residence of the Popes for about six centuries (since 1377). In fact, before the transfer of the Pontifical Court to Avignon (1309-1377), the Papal seat was at the Lateran. 266 Popes have sat on the throne of St. Peter in an uninterrupted line. Vatican city is an independent State ruled by the Supreme Pontiff (the Pope).

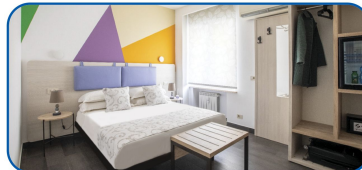

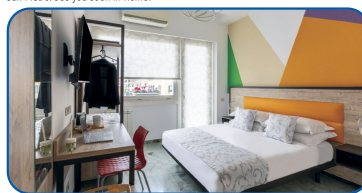
